





TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- ❖ All rates are quoted in Malaysian Ringgit (MYR) per villa per night and are subject to prevailing service charge and taxes.
- ❖ Rates are inclusive of daily breakfast.
- ❖ A minimum 2 nights stay is required.
- ❖ Check-in time is at 3pm and check-out time is by 11am. Late check-out before 6pm will be charged at 50% of the room rates.
- ❖ Peak season surcharge is applicable at MYR 200 per room per night from 22 December to 10 January or during festive periods and public holidays.
- ❖ Maximum occupancy per villa is 2 adults and 2 children aged below 11 years old in existing day bed, no 3rd adult accepted. The Signature Suite maximum occupancy is 4 persons.
- ❖ A compulsory Sabah Parks Conservation Fee of MYR35 on the first night and MYR25 on subsequent nights will be levied in the final bill on every guest including children, for every night of stay by Sabah Parks in support of their efforts to continue to preserve the ecosystem of the marine park and islands within.
- ❖ Room rates are subjected to government tourism tax ("Tourism Tax") of MYR10 per room per night. The Tourism Tax will be charged at the hotel and payment to be made upon check-out. Malaysian citizens (MyKad) and permanent resident (MyPR card holders) are exempted. It is mandatory to produce MyKad and/or MyPR and/or other relevant documents upon check-in for registration for identification of nationality and citizenship purposes.

GETTING TO GAYA ISLAND RESORT

Once you arrive at Kota Kinabalu International Airport, make your way to Gaya Lounge at Jesselton Point Ferry Terminal through a land transfer for check-in and you will be escorted to the jetty for a private speedboat departure to the resort.

LAND TRANSFER

Private vehicle transfer between Kota Kinabalu International Airport and Gaya Lounge located at Jesselton Point Ferry Terminal can be arranged at a fee, with a driving time of approximately 20 minutes. One-way cost per car is as below:

All transfer rates are subject to change without prior notice and are advised at the time of booking. Waiting charge applies at MYR 100++ per hour. 100% surcharge applies per car per way between 0000hrs to 0700hrs.

SEA TRANSFER

Travel time from the jetty at Jesselton Point Ferry Terminal to or from Gaya Island Resort is approximately 10 minutes. Scheduled speedboat timings are as below:

From Jesselton Point Ferry Terminal:	10am, 12pm, 2pm, 4pm, 6pm
From Gaya Island Resort:	11am, 1pm, 3pm, 5pm, 6.30pm

Return transfer cost for schedule speedboat:

One-way transfer cost for private boat charter:
